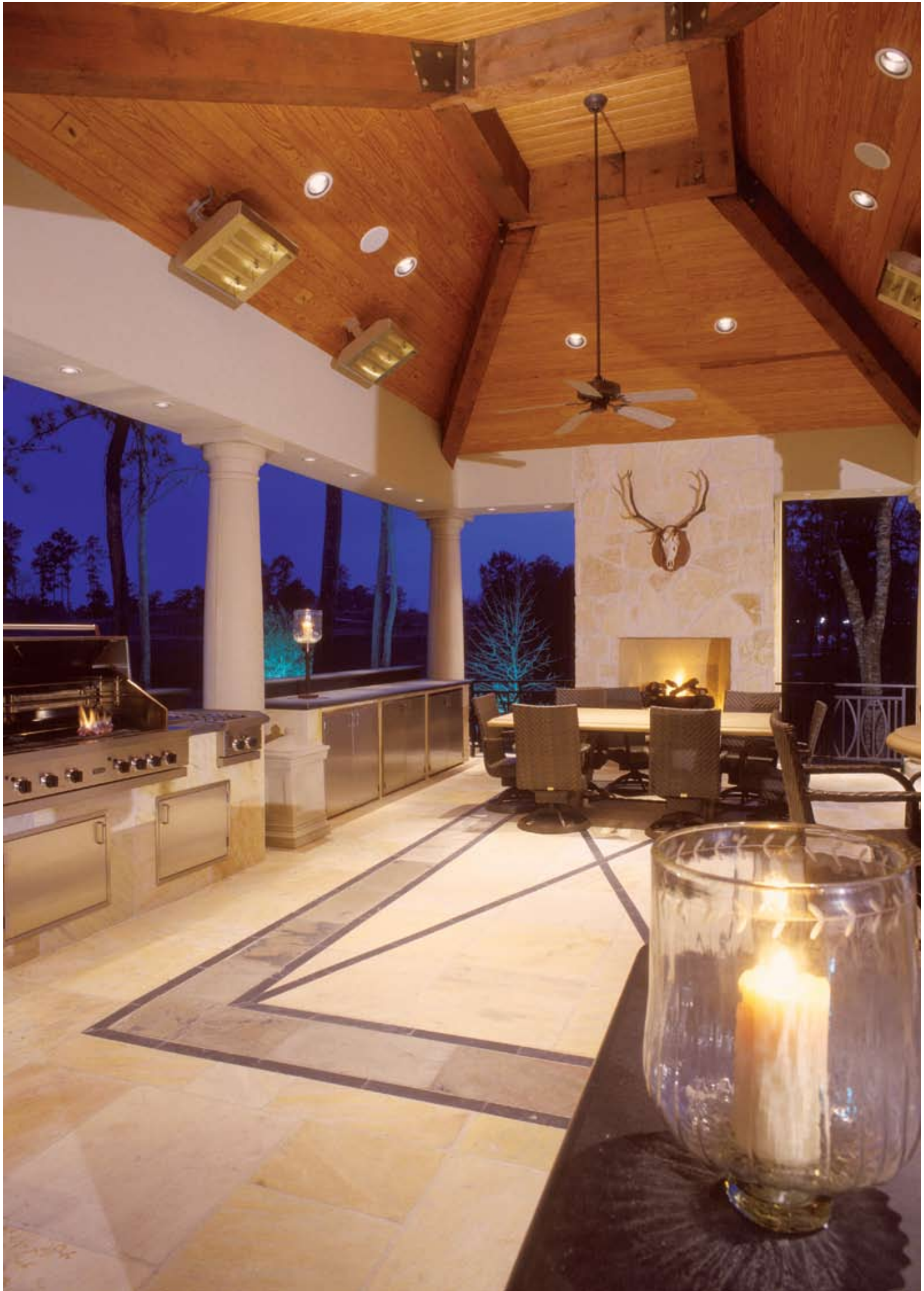

Above: Combining the subtle color and interesting textures found in the fabrics and furnishings make an elegant yet inviting formal living room. The custom carved stone fireplace with an inset antique mirror is the focal point and helps create the symmetry for the seating areas.

Facing page: Designed as a comfortable and relaxing retreat, this gazebo/pavilion area becomes a sanctuary for the homeowner in both winter and summer. Included is a stone sink, grill, side burners, under-counter refrigerator, ice maker and storage for rolling carts; the ceiling has electric heaters and a fan. The flooring design of the summer kitchen ties together all of the exterior entertainment areas and relates to the interior home floor patterns.

Right: My client requested an elegant formal powder room that would coordinate with the other formal entertaining areas of the home. Lit from below by small xenon lamps is an etched-glass panel that separates the vanity and toilet areas. A crackle cabinet, black granite floor, crystal bowl and wood veneer wallcovering add to the exquisite design of the space.

Facing Page Top: In a master bathroom of Roman proportions, a coffee bar, exercise room and water closet are among the many amenities. Attention is drawn to the butt-glazed window, which frames the view of the custom designed stone water wall. In order to make the room feel warm and comfortable, we chose stained and glazed custom cabinet and finishes, tile designs and a textural wallcovering.

Facing Page Bottom: High-rise living never looked as good as this elegant, high-style formal area. With a projector concealed in the ceiling, the living room doubles as a media room. When the lights dim, the projector drops down and the 100-inch screen—also concealed—unfolds from the ceiling.

Previous Pages: Designed for a busy family of four who enjoy cooking and entertaining, the kitchen is a culinary delight. In the design of this incredible kitchen, we combined painted and stained cabinets with a stainless and carved-stone range hood, a leaded-glass window and crystal chandelier. The long wall features two large cabinets with carved bonnet tops that resemble armoires. In addition to the refrigerator and freezer, the wall includes two microwaves, an additional oven, an LCD monitor and a concealed baking area.
